

SI. No.	The school is directed to ensure that :
1	The total number of sections of Bal Vatika shall be restricted to 03 (01 section each for Bal Vatika 1, 2 and 3 respectively). The total number of sections from classes I to X shall be restricted to 27. Further increase of sections shall be subject to specific approval of the Board on the basis of the request of the school as per affiliation bye law and availability of class rooms of greater than 500 sq. ft. dimension. The number of students in each class shall be restricted to 40.
2	The Composite science lab has not been equipped with safety features like exhaust fan and utilities like gas connection in work station. School has also not made provision of seating arrangement for students. Further, lab been seen without separate entry and exit. School shall make provision of separate entry & exits in all labs and upgrade the lab as per Board's SoPs within 03 months and submit the compliance with videography.
3	The school does not seem to have referred to RPwD Act and guidelines of the Board for CWSN toilets. The building is G+2, but only 2 CWSN toilets are seen for boys and girls. Regular cubicle has been converted into CwSN toilet for boys, which is too small and narrow for free movement of wheelchair/walker. Temporary wedge and raised entrance has been seen in CwSN toilet for girls. The School shall construct separate toilets for CWSN, boys and girls on every floor with proper permanent signage, indicating the floor number, as per norms of RPwD Act and guidelines of the Board within 3months and submit compliance on SARAS with videography.
4	Ramp/lift to access upper floors is not available. As school vide e-mail/letter dated 23.01.2024 has informed that work of construction of lift to access upper floors is under progress, school is hereby, directed to ensure completion of construction/installation of lift, as per the provision laid in RPWD Act and Board's guidelines (https://saras.cbse.gov.in/SARAS/Circulars/Circular05_2023.pdf) within 03 months and submit compliance.

The school shall ensure the training of its teachers with CoE Chennai within 3 months and submit the compliance.

Compliance of the above mentioned points shall be submitted within 03 months on the SARAS Portal. Failure to comply within the prescribed time shall invite financial penalty @ Rs. 50,000/- every month until compliance is submitted and shall debar the school from filling the registration and LOC of students class IX to class XII, as the case may be.

The approval of the Board as mentioned above, is subject to the following conditions:-

- The school shall be responsible for its genuineness of the documents/ data/ information uploaded by the school. In case of any discrepancies, action will be initiated against the school as per Affiliation Bye -Laws-2018.
- 2. The school shall follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt. from time to time. The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government concerned.
- The School shall apply online for extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws.
- 4. The school shall go through the provision of Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws and subsequent amendment therein as well as circulars and guidelines /instructions issued by the Board time to time and keep a copy thereof for reference purpose and is also advised to regularly visit CBSE websites i.e., http://cbseacademic.nic.in/ & http://cbse.nic.in/ for updates.
- 5. The school shall renew mandatory certificates from time to time.
- 6. The school shall be solely responsible for any legal consequences arising out of the use of school name/logo/society/trust or any other identity /activity related to running of school affiliated to CBSE. All legal expenses incurred by the Board, if any, arising out of these circumstances, shall be borne by the school.
- Concerned Regional Office is requested to create new email id of school as per direction issued by controller of examination. This E Mail ID is used for communication with CBSE only.
- 8. The school shall not remove the documents and videography links in the mandatory disclosure section of its website.
- The school shall follow the SOPs of the Board for its Laboratories, Library and sports facilities issued by the Board vide circular no 11 dated 04.10.2022.

If the compliance is not submitted with in the stipulated 3 months , the
